

# Ancaster residents to play big role in annual skating carnival

All roads lead to Dundas Friday and Saturday for the annual skating carnival of the Dundas Figure Skating Club in which a number of Ancaster residents are taking part.

Heading the list of participants from Ancaster is the president of the skating club, Dr. Donald A. Hitch, R. R. 1, Ancaster.

Evening performances are scheduled for 8.15 p.m. on Friday and Saturday evenings, with a matinee planned for 1.15 p.m. Saturday afternoon. A colorful Centennial background provides the theme for this carnival, long recognized as an outstanding event.

The show will open with a number entitled, "What is a Canadian?" It will show girls dressed in costumes of all the different provinces that make up Canada.

Other numbers will include scenes from across the Alberta Foothills, the West Coast Indians and Eskimos. One number will take the audiences back to 1867, another depicting the current day and a third projecting one into the future with the club's interpretation of the year 2067.

Star performers will include Donald Knight, 19-year-old Canadian and North American Senior Men's Figure Skating Champion who came forth in recent world championship in Austria. Knight is a resident of the Valley Town. With him will be Valerie Jones who with Knight returned recently from an European tour, that includes Russia and East Germany.

Mary Church and Tommy Falls will be the guest dance team. They were runners-up in both Central Ontario Sectionals and Junior Canadians.
